LDSHIS501A Review church development from its inception to the present day

Students will be provided the knowledge and skills required to develop awareness of the foundation and growth of the early church, its commission to reach the world, and lessons learned for application to the present day church. *Subject names for this unit: (Part A - Church History) (Part B- Book of Acts)*

LDSINT502A Understand and apply principles of intercession

Students will be provided the knowledge and skills required to understand the Biblical principles of prayer and intercession to effectively lead in team prayer. They will also develop an awareness of doctrinal truth concerning angelic and demonic beings in relation to prayer. *Subject names for this unit: (Part A - Intercession) (Part B - Angels & Demons)*

LDSBIB503A Establish Biblical interpretation procedures for homiletics and apologetics

Students will gain the knowledge and skills required to prepare Biblical studies communicating in the areas of interpretation, preaching, and apologetics. Application of the unit occurs where scripturally based understanding is required to equip people for practical faith-directed living. *Subject names for this unit: (Part A - Biblical Interpretation) (Part B - Homiletics) (Part C - Apologetics)*

LDSCSK504A Develop communication skills for pastoral care in the church

Students will gain the knowledge and skills required to develop communication skills and sensitivity to those needing in-service pastoral care on personal matters in a church. Application of the unit occurs within a church ministry prior to, during or after an altar call in a public setting. *Subject name for this unit: (Basic Counselling)*

LDSBKS505A Undertake an exegetical study of selected scripture

Students will gain the knowledge and skills required to analyse scriptural principles and identify applications from specific New Testament Books. They will receive a foundation and pattern for future study for personal life and for teaching and discipling others. *Subject names for this unit: (Book of Romans) (Book of Proverbs) (Letter to the Colossians) (Sermon on the Mount)*

LDSESC506A Develop understanding in Biblical eschatology

Students will gain the knowledge and skills required to understand and interpret the various prophetic scriptures on eschatology and place them in chronological sequence. The unit is designed to give a positive expectation for the future and so encourage a consistently holy personal lifestyle. Application of the unit occurs within an evangelical environment where end-time doctrine is taught. *Subject name for this unit: (Eschatology)*

LDSEVG507A Develop effective evangelism strategies

Students will gain the knowledge and skills required to reach others effectively with the Gospel using different strategies and styles of evangelism designed to cater for differing cultures, age groups, and social and religious demographics. Application of the unit occurs in a church/para church environment and in the community where evangelistic projects, outreaches and one-on-one evangelism may occur. *Subject name for this unit: (Effective Evangelism)*

LDSFTH508A Develop and apply faith building strategies

Students will receive the knowledge and skills required to develop and apply a mature understanding of the scriptural principles of faith and of faith building strategies to equip believers. *Subject name for this unit: (Faith Strategies)*

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LDSMIS509A Understand global mission

Students will receive the knowledge and skills required to participate in global missions with understanding and cultural sensitivity. Application of the unit occurs within a mission department in a church, para-church or overseas mission environment with a focus on cross cultural evangelism. *Subject name for this unit: (Global Missions)*

LDSHSP510A Develop understanding of the anointing of the Holy Spirit

Students will gain understanding in the anointing of the Holy Spirit and the outworking of His ministry in the life of the individual believer and corporately. The unit will assist them in developing sensitivity to the promptings and flow of the Holy Spirit for a prophetic lifestyle. *Subject names for this unit: (Part A - Understanding the Anointing) (Part B - Ministry and the Holy Spirit)*

LDSLEA511A Develop skills and attitudes for church leadership

Students will be provided with the knowledge and skills required to understand Biblical leadership structure, authority and delegation within the church. This unit also provides opportunity to develop effective Biblical leadership skills and attitudes. Application of the unit occurs where leadership skills and team concepts are required within a church environment. *Subject names for this unit: (Part A - Christian Leadership) (Part B - Christian Ethics) (Part C - Church Government)*

LDSMRF512A Develop scriptural knowledge on marriage and family relationships

Students will be provided with the knowledge and skills required to assist in developing scripturally healthy relationships in marriages and families. Application of the unit occurs within a Christian environment dealing with issues concerning relationships within marriage and the family. *Subject name for this unit: (Marriage & Family)*

LDSVIS513A Develop personal vision and gifting

This unit will provide the knowledge and skills required to foster a Biblical culture and develop personal vision and gifting to build and strengthen the evangelical church. *Subject names for this unit: (Vision and Gifting)*

LDSHEA514A Apply Biblical healing approaches

This unit will provide the knowledge and skills required to sensitively apply the principles, strategies and methods of Biblical healing in pastoral care situations. *Subject names for this unit: (Practical Healing)*
